**ADMISSION TO THE CULTURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM IN
CONDITIONALLY CLASSIFIED STATUS**

For Conditional Admission, the applicant applies to the Graduate Coordinator, Cultural Resources Management MA Program, Department of Anthropology and Linguistics, Sonoma State University, 1801 E. Cotati Ave., Rohnert Park, CA 94928. (Email john.wingard@sonoma.edu). Submission of the following is required:

1. Official transcripts providing evidence of at least a 3.0 grade point average in undergraduate and graduate courses already completed. Under unusual circumstances, this requirement may be waived for students who satisfy the University requirement of a 2.5 grade point average for the last 60 units of undergraduate education. Such waiver requires the unanimous approval of the Graduate Committee of the Department of Anthropology and Linguistics. Submit two official transcripts, one to the Office of Admissions, the other directly to the Department of Anthropology and Linguistics. *
2. A letter of application, describing interest in the program, previous experience and other qualifications, and career objectives.
3. A resume or curriculum vitae covering both educational and work experience.
4. An example of the applicant's written work (such as a university term paper, single-authored technical report, or published articles). It is understood that this submission shall represent the level of writing ability which the applicant is able to maintain in graduate courses and other related assignments. Where deemed necessary, the Graduate Committee reserves the right to require additional writing assignments as may be necessary to evaluate candidate's writing ability.
5. Recommendations from two (2) persons familiar with the applicant's professional potential.

There are no forms for application or recommendation. The GRE is not required.

Admission to the Program in Conditionally Classified status does not guarantee admission to full Classified Status. In addition to the above requirements, the Graduate Committee may require others, especially if the student's initial graduate work reflects deficiencies in graduate level skills.

****Please note--Admission to the University and admission to the CRM Program are separate procedures. The deadline for filing application for admission to the University is January for the following fall. Application materials for the CRM Program must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Department of Anthropology/Linguistics office (Stevenson Hall 2054) on or before January 31, 2010.
