This search will result in a three-year pool of qualified candidates. Positions are for one or more semesters of the 2009-2012 academic years.

THE UNIVERSITY: Sonoma State University is one of the 23 campuses of the California State University. Located in the Sonoma County wine country, 48 miles north of San Francisco, the University has an enrollment of approximately 8,000 students with 500 faculty. The University is organized into six schools: Arts and Humanities, Business and Economics, Education, Extended Education, Science and Technology, and Social Sciences. Within the traditional structure is an interdisciplinary program of liberal studies. The University offers bachelor's degrees in 42 fields and master's degrees in 15.

THE DEPARTMENT: The English Department has thirteen full-time faculty, 25 adjunct faculty and approximately 290 majors. The Department offers a B.A. in English with emphases in literature, credential preparation, and creative writing, and an M.A. in English with emphases in literature, rhetoric, and creative writing. DUTIES OF THE POSITION: The English Department anticipates temporary part-time positions to teach courses in Introductory and Applied Linguistics, including pedagogical and rhetorical approaches to grammar, the structure of English, language acquisition and language study for educators.

QUALIFICATIONS: To be recommended for appointment, the candidate must have: M.A. in Linguistics, Applied Linguistics or English Education (with Ph.D. preferred). The position requires expertise in preparing students at the undergraduate level for secondary single-subject certification in teaching English Language Arts. Experience should include courses in introductory linguistics, including language structure and acquisition as well as language study for educators. At least one year of full-time college-level teaching (or equivalent part-time teaching) is required. Secondary level teaching experience of English Language Arts preferred.

All candidates who meet the minimum qualifications are encouraged to apply.

RANK AND SALARY: Salary is dependent upon number of units assigned, educational preparation, experience, and availability of funds, subject to any CSU system faculty contract salary increases.

APPLICATIONS: Review of applications will be conducted for those applications sent by February 14, 2009.

Please submit a letter of application; a complete and current vita; full citations of major publications; research and philosophy of teaching statement; names, titles, and telephone numbers of three references, unofficial transcripts, and three letters or recommendation to be submitted directly from the recommender. When possible, please send the following electronically: a current teaching evaluation, if available; and other discipline related documents.

Application procedures for temporary faculty already teaching in the department:

- Temporary Faculty with three year contracts do not need to reapply.
- Temporary Faculty who have taught for the department within the past two years need only submit a letter of intent to remain in the pool. The hiring committee will review the Personnel Action File and then determine whether an additional interview would be beneficial.
