

**3.10. The institution has a chief executive whose full-time responsibility is to the institution, together with a cadre of administrators qualified and able to provide effective educational leadership and management at all levels.**

[Dr. Ruben Armiñana](#) is President of Sonoma State University and is accountable to the California State University (CSU) Chancellor and the CSU Board of Trustees. Dr. Arminana has been president at SSU since 1992.

Each campus President is evaluated in accordance with the CSU [Criteria for Presidential Assessment](#) assuring that the President's leadership is marked by high performance and appropriate responsibility and accountability. The [most recent review](#) of President Armiñana was in August 2005.

The President has appointed a Cabinet which represents the cadre of qualified administrators who provide effective educational leadership and management at all levels.

The performance of Cabinet members and Deans of Schools are assessed annually in accordance with the yearly [performance review policy](#).
