



## GREEK COUNCIL REPORT OF ALLEGED VIOLATION

Any member of the sorority and fraternity community may file a Greek Council Report of Alleged Violation form to request the conduct process be enacted to address the concern raised in the report.

The report must be filed within 30 days of the alleged violation and submitted to the Vice President of Greek Council in a sealed envelope in the Greek Council mailbox in the Center for Student Leadership, Involvement and Service in the Sonoma Student Union.

Reasons for filing the report may include, but are not limited to, the following: conflicts between individual members of chapters, individual chapters, Greek governing councils (Multicultural Greek Council, Panhellenic Council and Interfraternity Council), or a third party and chapters; or violations of the SSU Greek Community Standards, Sonoma State University policy and any other applicable policies.
