HOW TO SIGN UP

- 2) Turn in paid sign up form into the Front Desk of the Rec Center before the Due Date.
- 3) Attend mandatory manager meeting for your sport to receive rules, policies, procedures and to schedule your team into a league. Any team not represented at the manager meeting will receive a forfeit.
- 4) Game times will be posted in the Lobby of the Rec Center and online at IMleagues.com, they will **not** be given over the phone.

ELIGIBILITY

- Each person may play on only one Coed and one Mens or Womens teams for each sport.
- For sports played in the Recreation Center, each participant must be a member of the Recreation Center or purchase a temporary pass to the Recreation Center.

- Forfeit time is game time.
- A forfeit within the 1st week of play may result in removal of the team from the league without a refund
- Two or more forfeits by one team in a season will result in the team not being eligible for play-offs.
