

Fall 2009 REGISTRATION

Sonoma State University has initiated a two-pass registration process. The two-pass process replaces the prior practice of 1st and 2nd registration periods. The intent of this process is to ensure that all students have the opportunity to enroll in required prerequisite, major and general education courses.

Students eligible to enroll for the Fall 2009 semester will be assigned appointments within each pass period based on current standing.

Advisors should assist students prior to the first pass period with prioritizing courses most important to progress toward their degree.

During the first pass, undergraduate students may only enroll in 9 units. This provides all undergraduates with a better opportunity to obtain at least two courses needed toward graduation. Students who do not enroll during their first pass appointment period must wait until their second pass appointment to enroll.

During the second pass, undergraduate students may add courses up to 16 units.

An open registration period will still be provided—now with a greatly expanded time period—in which students may continue the practice of enrolling in up to 20 units and over 20 units with an approved petition to add more than 20 units.
