

SSALI POLICY ON CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

A SSALI student is permitted to take a limited amount of Sonoma State University course work through the Office of Extended Education while concurrently enrolled in the American Language Institute. No request for concurrent enrollment will be approved until the student has registered for SSALI and paid fees.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Students enrolled in SSALI who have a minimum TOEFL score of 500/61iBT may request Concurrent Enrollment in conjunction with part-time SSALI at the advanced level. SSU units plus SSALI hours must be equivalent to a full-time course of study. SSU units to equal a maximum of 75%.
- Students presently enrolled in SSALI who have already completed the advanced level of SSALI (full semester of Level 500 or 10 weeks of Level A) with a "B" average, and have a minimum TOEFL score of 485/56 iBT may request Concurrent Enrollment, (no more than two SSU courses, 50%).
- Students who are presently enrolled full-time in the advanced level, with a "B" average in previous SSALI course work, and have a minimum TOEFL score of 485/56 iBT may request Concurrent Enrollment, (no more than 1 SSU course, 25%).
- Students enrolled full-time in high intermediate to advanced levels may request permission to register for an SSU course requiring very limited language such as P.E. or dance.

PROCEDURE:

- 1 Consult the Sonoma State University schedule of classes. Select possible classes that are not in conflict with SSALI classes, preferably in late afternoon or evening.
- 2 Receive advising from the SSALI Advisor or Director.
- 3 Complete the Open University Registration Form available from the Extended Education Office.
- 4 Attend the first class meeting. If there is space in the class, ask the instructor to sign the form.
- 5 Obtain the signature of the SSALI Director on the Open University Registration form.
- 6 Pay tuition at the SSALI office according to stated Fee Categories.
- 7 Return the signed form to the SSALI Director.
- 8 Student must pay for open university courses at the published rate directly to Extended Education.

LIMITATIONS: Concurrent enrollment does not automatically lead to admission to Sonoma State University.

Calculation of units for Concurrent Enrollment

F-1 students must maintain full-time enrollment. Use this chart to determine how many hours of SSALI and how many units of SSU you can take.

| Full time | 20 hours/week | | | < 56 iBT |
| 75% time | 15 hours/week | 25% time | 3-4 units (1 course) | 56 iBT enrolled in Adv. SSALI |
| 50% time | 10 hours/week | 50% time | 6-7 units (2 courses) | 56 iBT completed Adv. SSALI |
| 25% time | 5 hours/week | 75% time | 8-10 units (3 courses) | 61 iBT |
