If you were placed in Math 45 Fall 10, you will need to make up a class. It is required that you enroll in winter or summer session to remain on track in the program. Junior/3rd year:

Take CSET: Multiple Subjects Exam this Spring/Summer. Visit www.cset.nesinc.com for more information. Don't forget to re-apply to the university as a post baccalaureate student during the initial S'11 application period of Aug. 1 – Aug. 31, 2011. Spring 2011 Registration

Use on-line registration during the Nov 29 – Dec. 3.

Pass One Registration, with fees due by Jan. 1, 2011 (up to 10 units).

Pass Two Registration is from Dec. 6 – Dec. 17 (up to 20 units).

- Once classes begin on January 31, 2011, **all full** LIBS classes will be restricted. This means you will need to GO TO THE FIRST CLASS. Exceptions: 337, 338, 340, 480 LIBS Special Projects – contact professor.
- Once you have secured a seat from the professor, you will need to go on-line and register within 24 hours.
- Remember to pay your fees by Feb 11th or you could lose all your classes.
- If you do **not** show up **on time** for the 1st class you are registered for, you will lose your seat if there are students needing the class.
- On-line Open, Add/Drop Registration is Jan. 31 – Feb. 11th.
- Go on-line and DROP any classes you don't want asap.

It is **VERY** important for you to register **at the time you are assigned** by Admissions & Records. This time is based on how many units you have completed. The closer you are to graduation, the earlier the registration time you receive. If you do not register then, you lose your advantage and other students may register for the courses you wanted.
