

# Teacher Preparation Courses for new Transfers (HutchinsTrack II) Requirements you may fulfill prior to enrolling in the major Effective Fall 2004 Revised: 2/20/08

**1) General Education:** Students who complete Hutchins LIBS Track II are exempt from the 9 units of Upper Division General Education requirement. For any remaining General Education requirements such as Ethnic Studies, US History, US Const. and State & Local Govt. please consult your online degree progress report and the 51 Unit GE Pattern *or* the 48 Unit Transfer GE Pattern if you entered SSU with at least 30 units of transfer credit.

**2) Science: Must complete 9 units (Can be used towards GE Science requirements.)**

Hutchins LIBS Track II requirements include subject matter preparation in Biological, Physical and Earth Sciences. Complete one Intro to Biology course. Choose one Physical Science course: Astronomy, Physics, or Chemistry. Also choose one Earth Science course: Geology or Physical Geography. Courses that combine content from two or more of these areas would help students complete subject matter requirements in a timely manner and prepare for the CSET exam. Be sure to complete a lab in one of these science courses.

**3) Visual & Performing Arts: Must complete 6 units (Can be used towards GE Humanities requirements.)**

Require one survey course in history of art. Also require one additional survey course in music, theater or dance. Suggested courses at SSU include: ARTH 210 or 211: Intro to Art History, THAR 102 or 103: Intro to History of Drama & Dance, MUS 400: Music for the Classroom (background in Music recommended), THAR 460: Drama for Children, THAR 470: Dance for Children.

**4) KIN 400: Elementary School Physical Education**

**5) Concentration**

Track II students complete a **12 unit** Subject Area Concentration in *one* of the following areas: Biological Sciences, Environmental Studies, Human Development, Kinesiology, Mathematics, Modern Languages, Physical Sciences, Reading and Literature, Social Sciences, Visual and Performing Arts. Consider starting your concentration now while waiting to transfer into Hutchins. Up to 6 units from another school may be transferred towards the Area of Concentration. See Hutchins Area of Concentration form for specifics.

**6) Math: Must complete 9 units**

**Math 300A: Elementary Nbr Systems & Math 300B: Data, Chance & Algebra** and your **General Education Math**. Math 150: College Geometry is the recommended SSU GE math course for Track II. See below for substitution information.

*\*If you have transfer credit for a 3-unit lower division Math for Elementary Teachers course, you are exempt from Math 300A; however, since a lower division course may not count toward the major, you must select 3 units of additional LIBS elective.*

*\* If you have transfer credit for a 3-unit upper division Math for Elementary Teachers course, you may substitute it for Math 300A.*

*\*If you have transfer credit for a 3-unit lower division Probability and Statistics course, you are exempt from Math 300B; however, since a lower division course may not count toward the major. You must select an additional 3 units of LIBS electives.*

**7) EDMS 470: Multicultural Pedagogy (3).** This class is a prerequisite for the following credential programs: SSU, San Marcos, UC Santa Cruz, San Diego State.
