

## LSEE Multiple Subject - CWS2 Pact Portfolio Tips

1. Videotape more than a fifteen-minute episode of teaching and learning. Ideally videotape at least two lessons.
2. Collect several sets of class work. You will analyze only one, but having back-ups is a smart plan.
3. You can pass the CWS2 portfolio with a few areas being reviewed as not passed—but you must pass the video and the academic language areas or redo them.
4. Use past tense in your written commentary. Often lessons are put into the portfolio prior to teaching them—but all the commentary should occur after you teach it.
5. When you render your video in QuickTime—DO NOT SELECT WEB mpg4 mode
6. Be sure and label your *at, below* and *above* learner as student A, B, or C only. No student or school names in your portfolio.
7. Submit your lesson plans for review to your 464 instructor
8. Submit your miscue analysis assignment for REVIEW to your instructor. You choose whether to put it in your CWS 2 portfolio or not.
9. Submit your writing sample analysis assignment for REVIEW. You choose whether to put it in your CWS 2 portfolio or not.
10. Submit your CWS2 to your instructor as SHARE
11. It is not OK to submit one big plan for your 3-5 day lesson sequence –even if your plan is a writing process.
12. Ask for your 3 days to work on your portfolio—released from the field right away—spread it out.
13. Use Colored ink, images and highlights to make your work stand out—use the media tool! Don't be a tool of the media!
