The La Luz Bilingual Center is in its 20th year of servicing the Sonoma Valley. It is a family service organization helping with basic needs (rent, utilities, food stamps, domestic violence, application needs, job discrimination complaints, to a predominantly Hispanic population, with the majority living under the poverty level.

Along with those basic needs we offer adult ESL Classes, Computer Classes, GED Class curriculums, mental health, dental and other medical services. Basic food distribution needs, Migrant Farm Worker Camps, Day Labor services, Youth Leadership Programs, a Parent Speak up Campaign, communication between adults and their children, regarding premarital sex, a children's summer lunch program, women's, yoga, dance and nutrition classes are some of the many programs La Luz offers to its clients.
