Harvest Lab Technician: Sutter Home Program - NAPA VALLEY and LODI

Begins approximately early July and ends approximately December.

This position will perform routine and special analysis on wine and its components including: sampling and analyzing wines in barrels and tanks, maintaining an accurate record of test results and procedures, and reading and interpreting results of analysis. The successful candidate will be able to work in a lab environment, follow instructions and take direction, work long hours (any shift 6-7 days per week), and have a valid California driver's license. There are opportunities in both the Napa Valley and Lodi locations.

Harvest Grape Graders: Napa Valley

Begins mid-August and ends beginning of November

This position will document all grape loads by weight tag number (include Grower and Variety, and make sure they match with scheduled deliveries), document brix levels, excessive rot, mold, juice status, any second crop, look for and document any anomalies such as Material Other Than Grapes (MOG), i.e. hydraulic fluids, irrigation debris, vines, branches, excessive leaf material and metal debris. Successful candidate will be able to follow written and verbal directions, clearly and accurately document information, perform physical labor, and will be available to work long hours, and have a valid California driver's license.

Harvest Cellar: Sutter Home Program - NAPA VALLEY and LODI

Begins mid-July and ends approximately December

This position assists the Winemaking and Cellar departments by shoveling pumice from tanks, pulling hoses, setting up pumps, assisting the staff with processing operations, and running machinery. The successful candidate will be able to follow written and verbal directions, perform strenuous physical work, work long hours (any shift 6-7 days per week), and have a valid California driver's license. Harvest Cellar: Trinchero Napa Valley & Napa Cellars/Folie a Deux Program

The successful candidate will be able to follow written and verbal directions, perform strenuous physical work, work long hours (any shift 6-7 days per week), and have a valid California driver's license. Harvest Grape Maturity Sampler: ST. HELENA, PASO ROBLES and LODI

This position will take samples of vineyard fruit, conduct brix analysis on fruit samples, monitor status of vineyards, and transport samples to the wine lab for processing. The successful candidate will be able to follow written & verbal instructions, spend the day outdoors sampling vineyards in a quick & efficient manner, work overtime including weekends and holidays, and have reliable transportation and a valid California driver's license. Experience with viticultural study and/or field farm/agricultural experience preferred.
