Interns are expected to assist in daily Crush activities or manage a portion of an ongoing project, depending on their level of experience. This is an excellent opportunity to gain hands on experience and increase your skill base for graduate school or future employment. You will assist Winemakers and associates in lab blends, tasting, grape grading, inventory control, cellar work, and sampling. You will also be involved in some aspects of winemaking from grapes through wine. Responsibilities for each intern will be determined based upon prior experience, ability to learn new tasks, and willingness to take on additional responsibility.
