

Pre-enrollment Immunization Requirements

CSU Policy & State law requires that students provide copies of official documentation of the following immunizations (or blood test proof of immunity) to the SSU Office of Admissions and Records **before the start of their first semester of classes at SSU, as described below:**

Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR): Required of students **born on or after 1/1/57**. Records must show completion of **two** MMR shots after 12 months of age and at least 1 month apart.

Hepatitis B vaccine (Hep B #1, #2, #3): Required of students who will be **under age 19 when their first semester at SSU begins**. Records must show completion of a **series of 3** Hepatitis B shots. **This requirement persists until fully satisfied, regardless of subsequent age.** (Typical sequence is a shot at 0, 1, & 4 months or 0, 1 & 6 months). Previous shots for which you have documentation need not be repeated.

Records sent must be photocopies of official immunization records showing vaccine type, dose, & date of each required shot (or copies of blood tests showing immunity), and **labeled with** the student's full name, birthdate & the name of the doctor or clinic. Copies of **California public school immunization records** with dates are also acceptable.

Those needing immunizations to meet the above requirements should get them ASAP from their health care provider or a Public Health Clinic and send records to SSU prior to the start of their first semester. Entering students may also get immunized at the SSU Student Health Center (SHC) prior to the start of classes (or soon thereafter) for a fee that covers the SHC's costs to purchase the vaccine, once they have paid their Enrollment Reservation Deposit or SSU registration fees.

Exemptions for medical, religious or permanent and profound personal belief require a signed informed consent & must be discussed with a SSU SHC nurse or doctor. Medical exemptions require a letter from the treating physician.

Exempted individuals may be excluded from campus as a public health measure during a disease outbreak. SSU is not responsible for negative outcomes related to exemptions or delays in completing immunizations.

Photocopies of the required records should be submitted to the SSU Admissions & Records Office **well in advance** of a student's 1st day of classes. A HOLD will be placed on the registration of students who have not submitted proof of full MMR immunization and at least the first dose of Hepatitis B vaccine by Census Date. Students must then complete any remaining Hepatitis B shots in the 3-shot series in the shortest medically possible time sequence in order to be allowed to register in the future.

Immunization HOLDS on registration are ultimately removed only when SSU receives proof of all required immunization doses.

Students should check their University e-mail accounts & Peoplesoft records and on a regular basis once enrolled for HOLDS and other important information, and comply with all requirements promptly.
