Women's and Gender Studies Department Queer Studies Minor—18 Units

The Queer Studies Minor gives students competency within a dynamic field of interdisciplinary scholarship related to lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender lives as well as queer approaches to normative and nonnormative gender and sexual structures and subjectivities.

The Queer Studies Minor can be used as an independent 18-unit minor for any recognized university major.

WGS 301	Queer Studies Lecture Series (Spring only)	1 unit
WGS 350	Gender, Sexuality, and Family (GE E)	3 units
WGS 455	Queer Theory/Queer Lives (Spring only)	4 units

Electives (6-8 units):

Two Interdisciplinary Sexuality-Themed Courses chosen in consultation with your Queer Studies Minor advisor.
